The sheaves had behaved themselves and remained upright in Hambleden Church, we had sung enthusiastically *We Plough the Fields and Scatter* and everyone was ready to step outside into the warm September sunshine for the harvest lunch at the Village Hall.

But once outside we stopped in amazement: during the Harvest Festival service it had snowed! We were confused. It was warm and sunny, yet the cottage roofs were white with fallen snow. We then realised that the village was a film set for the Christmas advertisement of a well-known department store. Things were

not as they seemed, but there again, things aren't always as they seem.

As we approach the beginning of our harvest services in the Hambleden Valley Churches throughout September and October, we know that we live in a world that is not always as it seems.

In Buckinghamshire, a seemingly affluent county, I discovered recently that one in eight children is living in poverty. In the beautiful countryside around us, our farmers – especially thinking of those in the Hambleden Valley - are met with all kinds of challenges, including weather-related, which affect their harvest, crops and animal feed.

But thankfully, harvest is also a time when we are able to make a difference. The Hambleden Valley already offers support to two foodbanks: Community Matters in Lane End and the One Can Trust in High Wycombe. However, following the summer holidays, stocks are always low or depleted as there have been no school meals available for the children.

At harvest time we have opportunities to replenish the stocks for those who find themselves needing to use the foodbanks. Goods can be brought to the harvest services - we have a wonderful variety of services on offer and would love to see you! Or perhaps come along to a special concert on 10th September (see inside for all details), raising funds for Community Matters, so that winter does not come early for families. And let's keep praying for our farmers, so that they are not left out in the cold.





What a lovely picture of Peter Taylor and Irene Barrett at Windsor Castle just after Peter had been invested as a Commander of the British Empire (CBE) by Anne, the Princess Royal. Congratulations, Peter.

In the era of 'fake' news it is so refreshing to have a dedicated, old school, real professional journalist recognised for a lifetime's work - reporting the 'facts'. Peter is renowned not only for his bravery in covering 'The Troubles' in Northern Ireland but for earning the trust of all sides in this decades long confrontation. His televised interviews with individuals who openly admitted murder, and who could easily have arranged his demise, will stay with many of us for years. He was a rare Englishman to be invited to Martin McGuinness's wake and one of the few English journalists invited to lan Paisley's memorial service.

Peter makes a very modest Commander within our valley, deserving of the term 'veteran' after more than fifty years of reporting and analysing conflict in Northern Ireland and elsewhere as well as writing ten books, including a landmark investigation into the tobacco industry.

Peter and Irene live above Hambleden at Parmoor and are regular consumers of Church Teas where they will be happy to share the experience of their special day at Windsor.

Watching on television the Trooping the Colour on Horse Guards Parade. I felt very proud that this parade represented so well the long history of the British Army's traditions. Personally, I believe it is unequalled anywhere else in the world. I did notice the occasional London pigeon alighting on the parade ground but it was soon forced to beat a retreat.

Historically the flag was always the rallying point on the battle field. As you will know, I served in the Suffolk Regiment. Trooping the Colour was an annual celebration wherever the regiment was serving. On this flag (Colour) were listed all the battle honours earned dating back several hundred years in many parts of the world. The Suffolk Regiment known as 'The Twelfth of Foot' was one of the oldest county regiments. I was never known for the excellence of mu drill so never featured in the regimental 'Trooping the Colour' party. Whatever our CO (Commanding Officer) thought about his role in the parade, he knew that it was the RSM (Regimental Seargent Major) who organised it.

#### NORTHEND AND MEDMENHAM



have returned since giving concerts there to make recordings.

There have now been 20 concerts in Northend since the series began in May 2022 including performances by such acclaimed artists as Lotte Betts-Dean, Huw Watkins, Mēla Guitar Quartet and Clare O'Connell as well as a host of rising stars from the Royal Academy of Music.

Establishing an audience for a new series, especially in a rural location, is a very slow process and although the audience for

events has grown over the past few years, attendance has been patchy. This is a problem when we are entirely dependent on ticket sales to keep the series going and, at present, we can only exist concert to concert. #### **MEDMENHAM**



He was born in 1936, a mile west of Marlow and went to school there, becoming head boy at Borlase. But his mother grew up in Medmenham, where her mother, Mrs Sartin, had managed the

village stores and post office in 1898. The family moved to Medmenham in 1946, firstly at 3 Ferry Lane (Sharrow Cottage) and then Olmeda.

After National Service in the Royal Artillery, Brian spent three years at Worcester College, Oxford reading History and representing the College at rugby, football and cricket. After university and a short time teaching in schools and the universities of Exeter and Liverpool, he was offered a lectureship in the newly-established department of War Studies at King's College, London, where he spent the rest of his career becoming Professor of Military History. He published widely and was particularly proud of supervising fifty successful PhD candidates.

In the years after he and Madeleine returned to Medmenham, they put a great deal of effort into village social activities running whist drives, helping at the fete, serving on the Parish and Amenities Councils and organising a series of winter talks in the Village Hall.

From his earliest days Brian had a deep

interest in birds and animals especially badgers and foxes, and spent many hours observing them in the woods above the village. He was sitting at the base of a beech tree one day when he heard loud snuffling nearby. Keeping very still a whole family of badgers, with cubs, passed almost over his feet in search of beech mast.

His mother was a devout Christian and Brian accompanied her to church and sang in the choir. He loved the church building itself, and felt a profound nostalgia for the generations of worshippers who have passed through the doors. He continued until recently to tend the family row of graves.
